

CCA Combats Proposed Scope of Practice Restrictions

The Industrial Medical Council (IMC) recently proposed a change in regulations that would add two more chiropractic specialty designations to the QME list. However, the California Medical Association (CMA) and the California Orthopedic Association (COA) have objected to this proposal and have presented written testimony in favor of eliminating all chiropractic specialties from the listing and merely listing "chiropractic." Because of the CMA's and COA's threat to the chiropractic scope of practice, CCA sought expert representation.
