Weightlifter Overcomes Injury to Win State Championship

After coming back from a shoulder stress fracture that threatened to end his weightlifting career, Palmer West student Michael Ludovico has won the 1996 California State Weightlifting Championships men's 220-pound division bench press event with a lift of 417 pounds.

Michael has a personal best of 465 pounds in the bench press and is now nationally ranked #10 in that event by AAU Powerlifting.

A graduate of the University of North Carolina (BA), and the University of Southern California (M.A.), Michael credits chiropractic care with helping him overcome his injury.
