Writing experience is required and an advanced degree in a related field is preferred.

According to the AHC, the position involves limited travel and will begin in January 2009. Produced twice annually, *Chiropractic History* is now in its 28th year of publication. It is indexed in Current Work in the History of Medicine, the Index to Chiropractic Literature, the Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL), Manual Alternative and Natural Therapies Indexing System (MANTIS), and selectively (1981 - June 1999) in PubMed.

The journal currently lists three associate editors and two assistant editors in addition to the editor, along with a three-person publication committee and 14-member editorial advisory board that includes Drs. Scott Haldeman, Donald Kern and Louis Sportelli, among others.
