

## New Personnel Appointments at Logan College of Chiropractic

Prior to joining Logan, Powell was athletic trainer at McKenzie Regional Hospital in McKenzie, Tenn., and brings 16 years of experience in athletic administration and student activities to his new position at Logan. He holds a Master of Science in Recreation and Sports Science from Ohio University in Athens, Ohio and a Bachelor of Science in Education from the University of Memphis. He is certified by the National Strength and Conditioning Association as a strength and conditioning specialist (CSCS) and by the National Athletic Trainers' Association as a certified athletic trainer (ATC).
