

Texas Chiropractic College Begins Nationwide Search for New President

The Texas Chiropractic College Board of Regents is pleased to announce a nation-wide search to identify and hire the 14th president in TCC's 106 years, and invites applications and recommendations for the presidency. A delegation of board members has been named to the presidential search committee, led by Dr. Monte Blue, TCC board chairman.

"The selection of the 14th President of Texas Chiropractic College is one of the most important tasks the Board of Regents has before it.
