Chiropractor Keynotes Oncology Meeting

Van D. Merkle, DABCI, DCBCN, CCN, a 1982 graduate of Logan College of Chiropractic, served as the keynote speaker at the Clinical Society for Integrative Oncology in Seoul, Korea earlier this year. Stanford Study to Investigate PEMF Therapy for Bone Fracture Healing
