Palmer Enjoys Record Enrollment

Palmer College of Chiropractic reports record enrollment at its Florida campus for the fall 2022 class - its highest since Palmer Florida opened its doors 20 years ago; with the main campus in Davenport, Iowa, boasting its highest enrollment since 2007. Observed Michael Norris, PhD, vice chancellor for admissions: "Applications to Palmer have been increasing over the past two years. Palmer College has invested heavily in the student learning experience over the past several years, and I believe we're seeing the positive impact of those strategic investments."

More than 2,100 students are currently enrolled across Palmer College's three campuses (Palmer, Palmer Florida and Palmer West): one in five chiropractic students in the U.S.
