Additionally, they donated six boxes of books from Dr. Rush's personal library to LACC's Learning Resource Center.

Dr. Rush began practicing in Huntington Park, California in 1941. From 1942-1945 he served in the armed forces. After the war, he returned home to practice. In 1954 he moved his family to Yuma, Arizona and became involved in the field of electronics, but continued to renew his chiropractic license every year until he passed away.
