Renwood S. Flagg, D.C., (PSC '28) was killed in an automobile accident on Tuesday, November 14, 1989, near his home in Rogers City, Michigan. The driver of the other vehicle had been drinking.

Dr. Flagg was born in Bath, Maine, in 1903 married Mary Faye Hoback (PSC '28) and established their practice in Rogers City, Michigan in 1928. He and Mary enjoyed the hospitality of B.J. Palmer and his wife Mabel, spending many an evening in dinner and conversation at the Palmer home. The philosophy of chiropractic was ingrained during these visits and Dr. Flagg continued the philosophy of straight chiropractic throughout his life.

His practice continued uninterrupted for 61 years until the day of his death. His style of treatment was directed at the patients' mental well being, as well as the physical well being, considering each one as if they were the only patient for the day.
